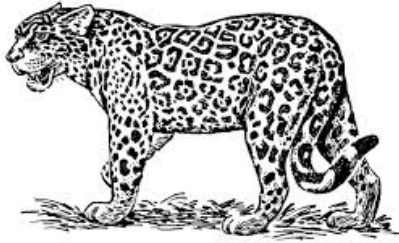


Jag Medallion



West Jordan High School has a diverse population consisting of students with many different talents and abilities. The purpose of the Jag Medallion is to encourage and challenge students to be involved in a wide variety of activities. The goal is to promote students that are well rounded and reward them for their efforts and achievements. The categories included in the Jag Medallion are listed on the next page.

The Jag Medallion will be awarded at the end of senior year. Some Points can be accumulated from all three years of high school. Seniors must have a minimum of **300 points** to apply for this award. All points must be verified by signatures from administrators, supervisors, counselors, teachers, advisors and/or coaches. **50 of the 300 points must be community/school service.**

***Community/School Service:** All community/school service must be fulfilled outside of regular school hours during **senior year**. A minimum of 8 hours is required. More than one activity can be combined. A one page documentation of your service project will be required and submitted with this form.*

***Super Fan:** This category includes any activities outside of regular school hours during **senior year**. (Games, Dances, Plays, Performances, etc.). Only 2 activities that are of the same type will be counted. The goal of the super fan category is to reward students who attend a variety of activities.*
